

CANNING SHOW 2025 INFORMATION TO STALLHOLDERS & FOOD VENDORS

TRADING HOURS:

- Friday 31 October 2025 - 2pm to 10pm
- Saturday 1 November 2025 - 10am to 10pm

ALLOCATION OF STALL SITES:

- CAHRS has the right and authority to re-arrange sites or move stalls to another location.
 - Should the Stallholder/ Food Vendor set up on the wrong site or outside their licensed area the Stallholder/ Food Vendor agrees to move to the correct site at the Stallholder's/ Food Vendor's own expense and without protest.
- Sites will be allocated to meet the preferred location nominated on the application, but an alternative site may be allocated at CAHRS discretion.
- Consideration will be taken to avoid similar type stalls being located close to one another. However, this may not always be possible. The decision of the CEO or Ground Steward will be final.

BUMPING IN:

- Stallholders/ Food Vendors bumping in from **9am-1.30pm on Friday, 31 October 2025**.
- Stallholders/ Food Vendors are required to set up and **be ready for operation by 1.30pm Friday and 9.30am Saturday**. No vehicles will be allowed to enter the Showgrounds after these times.
- Sites located on paved areas are not suited for pegs into the ground, and must be free standing.
- Sites located on lawn areas are not suited for pegs into the lawn, and must be weighted or free standing.
- All sites left on the Showgrounds overnight are at the Stallholder's/ Food Vendor's own risk.
- Stallholders/ Food Vendors must provide their own tables, trestles, chairs, stands and display equipment.
- Limited power is available on the Showgrounds and around the halls, request must be arranged in advance.
- All electrical equipment must be tested & tagged within 6 months of the date of the Canning Show issued by a licensed electrician.
 - Any items not tagged may be tested by the Showgrounds electrician at the vendor's cost. Charges will be billed accordingly.

BUMPING OUT:

- Vehicles are not allowed onto the Showgrounds during the opening hours.
- Bump out vehicle movement must happen after 10pm on Saturday, and last no longer than 1 hour past event close.
- The Stallholder's/ Food Vendor's commitment to the Canning Show is for the entire duration of the trading times, if you wish to leave early you must ask the CEO or Ground Steward and vacate the Showgrounds without the use of a vehicle.
- CAHRS does not accept liability for equipment, stock or any other item left on the showground by vendors. at any time.

BINS & RUBBISH:

- Stallholders/ Food Vendors are responsible for their own litter. Green bins and skip bins are located around the grounds for that purpose.
- Packaging must be flattened and deposited neatly in the skip bins. Stallholders/ Food Vendors who fail to maintain a clean area will be charged an additional fee.
- Upon bumping out, Stallholders/ Food Vendors must remove all their property and any rubbish on their site and make good of any damage caused by their occupation, to the satisfaction of CAHRS. Failure to do so will result in any restoration and or rubbish removal costs being charged to the Stallholder/ Food Vendor.

STAFF ENTRY:

- Stallholders/ Food Vendors will be allocated wristbands for staff for the duration of the Show.
- Wristbands must be worn by staff and visible to stewards/ security.
- If not distributed beforehand, wristbands are to be collected upon entry to the Show during trading hours.
- Wristbands are only for staff members and are non-transferrable.

PARKING:

- There is NO PARKING for Stallholder/ Food Vendor vehicles inside the Showgrounds during the Show. Any vehicle left in the Showgrounds during restricted times will be towed at the vendor's cost.
- Stallholders parking details (outside the Showgrounds) would be advised when get closer to the date.

WA PLASTICS BAN:

- Canning Show endorses the WA Plastic Ban for both Stallholders and Food Vendors alike. Stallholders/ Food Vendors are banned on below items:
 - All plastic shopping bags with handles
 - Disposable plastic utensils - straws, stirrers, and cutlery
 - Disposable plastic foodware - plates, bowls, food containers and lids
 - Expanded polystyrene food containers and trays
 - Disposable plastic cups
 - loose-fill expanded plastic packaging
 - Degradable plastics
 - Disposable cotton buds with plastic stems
 - Microbeads in rinse-off personal care, cosmetic and cleaning products
